Our Prep students have had a fantastic start to the year, diving into lots of exciting learning!

Reading

In Reading, students have been developing their comprehension skills through strategies such as making connections, predicting, summarising, critiquing, and inferring. They've also been exploring letters, sounds, and words during daily phonics sessions and learning about concepts of print to support their growing reading skills.

Writing

Each Monday, Prep students take part in journal writing, reflecting on and recording their weekend adventures. They're learning to use classroom tools and apply the sounds and letters they've been learning to help them put their ideas onto paper.

Inquiry

In Inquiry, students have been learning about the Zones of Regulation—a framework that helps them recognise and understand their emotions. They've been learning to identify what different feelings look like in themselves and others, and practising calming strategies






